## **DESCRIPTION OF SOURCES**

- Pencil sketch (ca. 1917–18) partially overwritten in ink, on staves 12 & 13 of a previously unused 16-stave page of *Symphony No. 1*, 2<sup>nd</sup> mvt. sketches (sharing with 2<sup>nd</sup> page of *Study No. [15]*); headed "II" (*Study No. [15]* is headed "I"). Identified by Ives as *Study No. 16* on a Photostat of p. [2].

[2] (f4802), 16 quarter beats (photostat, now lost, has memo "marked in copy #16"); memo below: "(nice eatin pie | -des[s]ert included)- | see back p 14, S[ymphony] #1"; memo at bottom of page (may refer to *Study No. [15]*): "Now, R[ollo]-here is something nice to eat after | your hard work—Guly[?]".

## **CRITICAL COMMENTARY**

This edition is based solely on **S**. All of Ives's accidentals are retained here.

- m. 0, Tempo: S appears to have literally "Andant Colair[?]" (here, interpreted as "Andante cantabile").
- 0: Originally S had triplet  $\longrightarrow$ , then triplet designation "3" erased and beam added to change to duplet (as here).
- 1, 1. .: S lacks stem (supplied editorially).
